The Rule provides a multifaceted framework for all 8,100 Texas public schools to add safety measures, including a requirement for exterior doors containing glass and exterior ground-level windows that could permit entry to be modified/reinforced with, for example, forced entry-resistant film.

With over 100 schools already installed in Texas, Patriot Glass Solutions – powered by C-Bond Systems' technology – is the "best-of-breed" solution for all schools. The Company's proprietary technology stops bullets and holds the glass and window film together providing the leading solution for schools across Texas and nationwide.

Patriot Glass Solutions offers security film products to deter forced entry and provide ballistic resistance. [C-Bond Secure](#) is stronger than just security film alone. C-Bond Secure, the Company's proprietary glass strengthener, is applied directly to the window prior to the application of window film to increase the strength and flexibility of the underlying glass. When used in conjunction with security film, C-Bond Secure delays forced entry, which gives law enforcement or other security personnel more time to lead those inside a facility to safety and apprehend the perpetrator.

[C-Bond BRS](#), a ballistic-resistant film system, includes C-Bond's glass strengthening technology and multiple layers of security film to help stop bullets from penetrating glass. C-Bond BRS is certified by third party labs to meet National Institute of Justice Level I, Level IIA, Level II, and Underwriters Laboratories (UL) 752 ballistic-resistant protection standards.

Among other school security initiatives passed during the latest legislative session, the final TEA Rule mandates that, "Unless inside an exterior secured area, doors constructed of glass or containing glass shall be constructed or modified such that the glass cannot be

easily broken and allow an intruder to open or otherwise enter through the door (for example, using forced entry-resistant film)."

The TEA Rule also mandates that, "Except when inside an exterior secured area, all ground-level windows near exterior doors that are of a size and position that permits entry from the exterior if broken shall be constructed or modified such that the glass cannot be easily broken and allow an intruder to enter through the window frame (for example, using forced entry-resistant film)."

Michael Wanke, President of Patriot Glass Solutions, stated, "The TEA's final Rule for school safety provides practical solutions to the changing security landscape and the growing demand for advanced safety measures within schools across Texas," stated. "Hopefully the TEA's action will serve as a road map for other educational agencies in states throughout the country to take a proactive approach to increasing school safety for students, teachers, and staff."
